support the global polio eradication effort.

Rotary is committed to raising \$50 million per year over the next three years, with every dollar to be matched with two additional dollars from the Gates Foundation. This expanded agreement will translate into up to a total of \$450 million to support the Global Polio Eradication Initiative.

"Eradicating polio requires the dedication and generosity of nations and individuals around the world, and Rotarians are again leading the way," said Melinda French Gates, co-chair of the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. "Rotary International and Rotarians continue to be the heart of GPEI – and have been since the beginning. The Rotary Foundation Board of Trustees recently approved a \$50 million grant for AFRO surveillance, Afghanistan, Pakistan and Outbreak Response. These grants will support ongoing immunization activities to reach children under the age of five with an emphasis on improving community awareness and engagement—promoting vaccine acceptance, reducing the number of missed children—and ensuring robust surveillance capacity to quickly detect poliovirus transmission.

Polio—a paralyzing and sometimes deadly disease—is on the verge of becoming the second human disease in history to be eradicated. This critical funding helps ensure that children in at-risk countries are protected from polio, and that the wild poliovirus is eliminated in the last two countries that continue to report cases.
