RBVians showed their large heart by contributing liberally to this cause which was complete with assistance from the government of Karnataka.





Tracking RBV's Projects at BADAMARANAHALLI over the years



Badamaranhalli is a small village situated near Baragur of Sira Taluk, Tumkur District. Total population of the village is 800- 1000 people. Village lagged behind in all sectors without much development happening and was economically very backward. These aspects made Rotary Bangalore Vijayanagar take few initiatives to develop the village and took a pledge of making this village a model village. Mr. Manjunath was the first point of contact who introduced Badamaranahalli to Rotary Bangalore Vijayanagar.







During 2016-17, Rtn. Hemanth, the then president, took a few initiatives to begin our activities. During this tenure RBV distributed sports materials to the Government School of Badamaranahalli and the students of the same school exhibited their talent by performing "KOLATA" at the ICGF programme held at Bangalore.

2017-18, Rtn. Venkateshwaran, the then president took the mantle from previous president and RBV did many projects at this village during his tenure. RBV adopted this village



formally in this period and appointed Mr. Manjunath as RCC. In this tenure RBV conducted a Health camp, Distributed Blankets, Donated Kitchen equipment to School, Donated a Computer, Planted about 100 Saplings in the village and one Class room of the government school was renovated and got painted.



During 2019-20 Rtn Umesh the then president, RBV organised one sports meet for the children of Badamaranahalli, Donated tabs and one more class room got renovated, sponsored by Past President Rtn P.V. Rai.



Due to COVID there was a gap of almost 2 years, again RBV was in action during 2021-22 under the able leadership of Rtn. Mehul Shah, Distributed few blankets to the needy, SSLC study materials were distributed to SSLC students under the Vidya Nidhi project and inaugurated the classroom which was renovated by RBV earlier. Also planned to take up painting of the school building, initiate "Gruhalakshmi", a woman empowerment programme and a tree plantation is planned during end May 2022.
