






Greetings Dear Rotarians!



- **Is it the TRUTH?** TRUST. From the Rotarian Code of Conduct, act with integrity and high ethical standards.



 are known for being sociable and building relationships. Ensure the process is civil and there's a feeling of respect and openness to ask
 questions that can lead to creative and innovative solutions. Discuss and agree on desired outcomes.







